Majesty by the merits and Intercession of Jesus Christ to Receive into the Number of
the Righteous and for my mortal Body I desire may be committed to the Earth to be buried
in a Christian and accoustable manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named
and as to my Temporal Estate which the almighty has been pleased to bestow upon me I give
and Dispose of in manner and form following

Item I Give to my loving wife Mary Robinson all my Estate Both Real and personal during her
Natural life & after my wife Dies I Give as followeth

Item I give to my Daughter Mildred Bell (Puck) and Arrey to her and her heirs for ever after my wife Dies

Item I give to my Son Samour Robinson the plantation & tract of Land whereon I now live also
Frank Lucy & Jim my one third part of my personal Estate after reserve of ten pounds
which I give to my grand child Mary Bell to him & her heirs forever after my wife
decease

Item I give to my daughter Rebecca Robinson, Robin, Ben, Peter & Fanny. All the rest of my
personal Estate that is not mention'd before to her & her heirs forever after my wife
decease

Item I give to my grand daughter Mary Bell Ten pound to be put upon Interest like the
Day she comes of age to marry to her & her heirs forever after my wife decease

Item I desire my Estate may not be Inventoried nor apprais'd I desire my Executors hereafter
named to give no Security

Item I leave my loving wife Mary Robinson Executrix & my Uncle Edward Powell Executor
of this my last will & Testament utterly revoking & disannulling all other wills & Testaments
made by me as Witness my hand the day & year above written
