Item I leave my wife the use of my Plantation together with the use of all the Remaining Part of my Estate of whatsoever Nature or kind it be during her Life or Widowhood and her Marriage to be Equally Divided Between all my Children all the Estate of whatsoever kind it be to be sold to the Highest Bidder and the Money arising from such Sale to be Equally Divided amongst them all.

My will is that there shall be no Appraisement of my Estate.

I do appoint my wife Sarah Executrix of this my last will and testament Ratifying and confirming this and No other to be my last will and testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Affixed my Seal this Day of 1768-

Now I do give and bequeath to my wife Arney all the remainder part of my Estate during her Natural life or Widowhood or until my eldest Son Arrives at the Age of Twenty one for the bringing up my Children and my will and desire is that at my wifes Death or Marriage or when my eldest Son Arrives at the age of Twenty one. That the whole estate shall be equally divided between my wife and Children by two discreet persons. Also my Will and desire is that if my estate should ever be divided as above and my wife have a separate part thereof that at her death it may return to my Children & be equally divided between them. And also my will & desire is that if either of my sons die under Age unmarried that what I have herein given him may be equally divided between the survivors. Lastly I appoint my Brother John William Thomas Chappell & my wife Arney Executors & Executrix of this my last Will and Testament.
