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In the Name of God Amen, I James Chappell of the County of Sussex and Parish of Allmarle being Old and infirm in Body but of Sound and Disposing mind and Memory at this Day it being the thirty first Day of October — in the year of Our Lord Christ One Thousand seven hundred and sixty eight make and bequeath this my last will and Testament in the Manner and form following Viz. I bequeath my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God after ^{his} happy life and my body to be decently Buried at the Discretion of my executors hereafter Named. And touching such worldly estate as I have Blessed Almighty God to bestow upon me I give & Devise in the manner following.

Impurities I Give my Son James Chappell Power to get Timber off the Plantation I now live on for the Use of his Plantation During his life I Also give my said Son James Chappell One Negro Man called Ben my part of the brandy Still One Feather bed and Furniture my free Man my Ring Saddle & Bridle and great Bible.

Item I Give my Son Thomas Chappell Seventy Pounds Current money.

Item I Give my Daughter Elizabeth Mafes One Negro Girl called Sarah one Negy boy called Harry & Twenty Shillings to buy her a ring.

Item I Give to my Daughter Mary Six One Negro Girls called Hannah & Leah and Twenty Shillings to buy her a ring.

Item I Give to my Daughter Sarah Mafes One Negro Girl called Peggy and One Negro Man called Jacob.

Item I Give my Daughter Rebecca Northington One Negro Man called Dick and One Negro Girl called Judy.

Item I Give to my Grand Son Thomas Tatum if he should to the Age of Twenty One years Forty five Pounds of money in the hands of James Smith to be paid out by my executors for as likely a Negro girl as can be bought for that Price to be bought in two years from my Death (But my will and Desire is if my said Grand son Thomas Tatum should Die before he comes to the Age of twenty One years that then the said Forty five pounds or Negro to Increase if any go to my Grand son Thosett Tatum & his Heirs.

Item I Give to my Daughter Amy Smith all the residue of my Money in the hands of James Smith after Paying the Forty five Pounds to my Executors for the Use of my Grand son Thomas Tatum.

Item I Give to my Son John Chappell One Negro man called Roger the land and Plantation whereon he now lives containing two hundred and Forty Acres More or less and One Feather bed and Furniture the same and Negro I Give to my said Son John Chappell and his Heirs forever.

Item I Give to my Daughter Lucretia Gordon One Negro Woman called Lucy One Negro Girl called Mary One Iron Still one Gray Horse and three Cows & Calves.

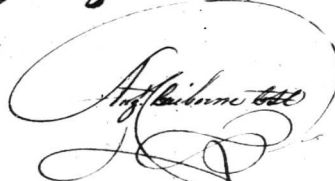

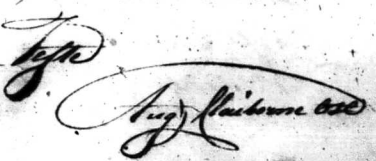
