In the Name of God Amen I John Edmund of Sussex County being sick and weak in Body but of disposing Mind do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in Words and manner following viz.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife the Plantation whereunto I now live but only with part of it as lies on the North side of the Road leading from Blackwater Bridge to the Newnham Church, during her natural Life -

Item I Give unto my Son Thomas all the rest of my said Tract of Land together with that part before given to his mother for her Life to him his Heirs and Assigns forever -

Item I Give unto my Son James to him his Heirs and Assigns forever all the Land that I own on both sides of the Upamuck Swamp, which I bought of Benjamin Ruffin junr. & his wife, William Edwards and Richard Jones & his wife, containing in the whole about one thousand and seventy five Acres be the same more or less.

Item I Give to my beloved wife my Son Thomas ^{my Son} my Son James and Alexander all my Negroes to be equally divided amongst them by my Executors the Survivors or Survivor of them when my wife marries, my son Thomas arrives to the Age of twenty five years or returns from England.

Item After my just Debts and Legacies are paid I Give all the Cash I have due to me or have in Trade to be equally divided between my Children Alexander Susannah Charlotte & James -

Item My whole Estate notwithstanding the Devices made above I Give may remain upon the several Plantations under the Direction of my Executors the Survivors or Survivor of them for the maintenance of my Wife and all my Children until a Division shall be made as above directed and after such Division my Will is that there may be a quantity of Corn Stock and Tools left on each of my Plantations as may be thought sufficient for the Use of the Plantations by my Executors to continue on them for the Use of my Wife my Son Thomas and my Son James and if at the Dissolution of the Partnership between Edwards and Edmund there should be any Money arising from the sd Trade after Contributing all along to the support of my Family & Plantations I Give it to be equally divided between my Son Alexander and my Daughters Susannah Charlotte and James.

Item I do here by appoint my Executors herein after named the Survivors or Survivor of them Guardians to my several Children until a Division of my Estate shall be made as before directed and Desire that they may have full power to enter into Articles of Agreement with the above named Edwards for putting all Monies due to my Son Alexander and my Daughters Susannah Charlotte & James into the said Trade and in that case no other of my Devices are to become Chargeable to the said Store after the Dissolution thereof.

Item It is my Will and Desire that after the Death of my wife the Negroes allotted to her may belong to my Son Thomas his Heirs and Assigns and the Stock with the Tools and all the part of my personal Estate which she may possess may be equally divided amongst my Children Alexander Susannah Charlotte & James the Use of the Negroes and personal Estate being given to my said Wife during her Life only.
