

June Court 1766 Lxxv XXX

In the name of the Lord Amen John Jarrat of Supra
County being weak of Body, but a perfect mind and memory desired be
Just for it. But calling to mind the uncertainty of life and it is appointed
once for all men to die. Do make and Ordain this my last will & Testament
in Manner as followeth, that is to say, first I Commend my soul to
the Lord; that I give it --- & my body to the Earth to be decently buried at
the discretion of my Executors Hereafter shall mention
I Give two thousand & sixty three Acres of Land lying and binding on
the East side of Berkes Branch to William Turner and James Turner
to him & to his Heir & also one Negro Boy named Jack
I Give the Remainder of the said Tract of Land to Edmund Turner & one
Negro Woman named Matt to him & his Heir.
I Give one Negro Woman named Jack to Martha Turner Daughter of James
Turner to her & her Heirs.
I Give one Negro Woman named Judea to Nancy Turner Daughter of the
said Turner to her & her Heirs.
I Give one Negro named Ningo and one named Peter and all my stock
and Household furniture to James Turner to him & his Heirs.
I Give one Negro Man named Sam to Jacob Wallis to him & his Heirs
I Give one Negro Man named Harry to David Turner to him & his Heirs
I Give one Negro Boy named Shepherd to Jesse Wallis to him & his Heirs
I Give the use of one Negro Woman named Judea to my Sister Sarah
Wallis & after her death to James Turner.
I Give ^{the remainder} all the part of my Estate to James Turner My Will is that James
Turner and Jarrat Wallis to be Executors to this my last will and Testament
(Disallowing all other wills made theretofore by me) --- In Witness my hand
and seal this the Twenty eighth day of October 1765

At a Court held for Supra County the 19th day of June 1766
The last will & Testament of John Jarrat deceased was presented
into Court by James Turner one of the Executors therein named who
made oath that he was the law doer & the same was proved by the affirmati-
on of Stephen Hamlin & Jarrat the oath of Siller Edmunds the
Witness thereto & by the Court appeared to be true & on the motion of the
said Executor Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof
in due form
