 in the County of Jersey being in good health and of a sound perfect Disposing  
 mind & memory thank be to Almighty God for the same and calling to mind  
 the uncertain Estate of this Frambly life that all flesh must yield unto Death  
 whenever it shall please God to call us hence and certain this my last will & testament  
 first of all I command my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it hope-  
 ing through the merits & intercession of my only sincerely redeme Jesus Christ Obtain  
 fully & respond of all my sins & to Inherit everlasting life & as to my body I command  
 to the earth from whence it came to be decently Interred at the discretion of my Executor  
 hereafter named and as to my Temporal estate wherewithal it hath pleased God to  
 bless me withall I Give & devise & dispense (of the same) in manner & form following

Item I desire that all my just debts & funeral expences be duly paid & discharged  
 Item I desire my loving wife Mary Tatton have the use & benefit of my plantation during  
 her Natural life & also my daughter Mary Young the use of the said Plantation

During her natural life after her mother's decease

Item I give & bequeath unto my Grandson Frederick Young his Heirs forever my plantation  
 above mentioned with all the land & improvements thereto belonging lying in the  
 Hundred of Herstmonceaux by computation to be the same more or less to begin at the  
 mouth of a Slack or low Ground between my plantation & Robert Tattons on Josephs  
 swamp on the south side thereof & running up the said Slack to St. John  
 black oak by a road known by the name of Chitones road thence along the said  
 road to Robert Tattons and along his tract to Josephs swamp & bounded by the Va-  
 rious water courses of the same to the place first begun at

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Grandson Frederick Young my feather Bed & furniture  
 of the like (as a young man)

Item All the rest and residue of my Estate I leave the use of to my Loving Wife Mary Tatton  
 during her Natural life & after her decease I Give & bequeath the same to my daugh-  
 ter Mary Young & her Heirs forever.

Item My Will is my Estate be not appraised

Item I leave my son in law Thomas Young to and appoint him to be sole Executor  
 of this my last will & Testament hereby revoking & disannulling all former wills  
 & testaments by me made in the time whereof I have herunto set my hand &  
 affixed my seal this 29<sup>th</sup> day of January One thousand Seven hundred & 14  
 four
