In the Name of God AMEN I Matthew Parkham of the County of Sussex being and Weak but of a sound disposing mind and Memory do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say I give and devise to my grandson Robert Parkham my Land and Plantation whereon I now live to him his Heirs and Assigns for ever Also I give and bequeath to my said grandson his Heirs and assigns One Negro man named Andrew one Negro Boy named Simon One Negro Boy named Arthur One Negro woman named Anna two Cows four Ewes five of my best Hogs two Sows ten Sheep five Hoss Two Axes and one Black Mare all which Negroes Stock &c are to be kept on the said Plantation and the profits arising therefrom are to go to the maintenance and Education of my said grandson and I leave the Care and Education of my said grandson with the Land Negroes Stock & other Estate given him under the direction and management of Thomas Parkham and Eliza Parkham until he shall arrive to the age of Twenty one Years for this trust reposed in them they are not to give Bond and Security but it is my will and desire that if my grandson should die before he arrives to the Age of Twenty one Years that my daughter in Law Lucretia Parkham may have two of the slaves which I have devised to him to wit Simon and Arthur and in that case I give her the said Two slaves to her her Heirs and Assigns

I give and devise to my said grandson and to his Heirs and Assigns my Second Best Bed and furniture Three Leather Chairs three flag Chairs one Black Walnut oval Table one Copper Kettle and One Chest all which my Daughter in Law Lucretia Parkham is to have the use of until my said grandson shall arrive to the age of Twenty one Years

I give and devise to my Daughter in Law Lucretia Parkham and to her Heirs and Assigns one fourth part of my Crop now making also two Pewter Dishes two Basins six hard Malle Plates six common Plates the smallest Iron Pot I have Eight of my best Hogs and one Sorrell Roan Colt and it is my desire that she may live on my Plantation during her Widows Hood and have the Liberty during that time of working three hands on the said Plantation

I give and devise to William Wynne his Heirs and Assigns One Negro man named Tom one Negro man named Dan and One Negro woman named Bet with her present and future Increase

I give and devise to my Granddaughter Ann Wynne Daughter of William Wynne one Negro Girl named Minny to her and her Heirs and Assigns

I give and devise to Eliza Parkham his Heirs and Assigns one Negro woman named Phillis with all her present or future increase

I give to my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Parkham Daughter of Eliza Parkham Ten pounds in Cash and my best Bed and Furniture

I give and devise to William Sturdivant his Heirs and Assigns one Negro man named Nicholas one Negro boy named Tom and one Negro Woman named Sarah with her present and future increase

I give and devise to Martha Sturdivant my Grand Daughter and the Daughter of William Sturdivant one Negro Girl named Peg to her and her Heirs and Assigns

I give and devise to Thomas Parkham son of William Parkham one Negro man named Peter to him his Heirs and Assigns

I give and devise to my Grandson John Sturdivant son of Mathew and Martha Sturdivant One Negro Girl named Lucy which said Negro formerly lent to my said Daughter Martha Sturdivant which said Slave was lately in the Possession of John Bates of the province of South Carolina I give the said Slave to the said John Sturdivant his

Heirs and Assigns Lastly I give and devise to William Wynne and William Sturdivant their Heirs and Assigns all the remainder and Residue of my Estate whatsoever which I have not already disposed of and I hereby constitute and Appoint the said William Wynne and William Sturdivant my true and lawfull executors of this my Last Will and Testament and I desire that they may not give Bond and Security for the trust reposed in them I also desire that my Estate may not be Appraised
