In the name of God Amen, the sixth day of December, in the Year of our Lord, Christ, One Thousand, seven hundred & sixty five, I Thomas Fells of the Parish of Allmarale in the County of Supers being of sound & disposing mind & memory thanks be to Almighty God for the same & calling to mind the certainty of Death and the Uncertainty of this Transitory Life, Do make Constitude & ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner following. First I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God, hoping for salvation through the merits & mediation of my blessed Redeemer Jesus Christ, and as for my body I Recommend it to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor, hereafter named and as for my worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with, after my just debts are paid, I Give and dispose of as follow.

Item I Give to my loving Son Nathaniel Fells Three pounds Current money, to be Raised out of my Estate

Item I Give & Bequeath unto my loving Son John Fells three pounds Current money to be raised out of my Estate.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my loving Daughter Ann Seal, wife of Robert Seal, Three pounds Current money to be raised out of my Estate.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my loving Daughter Sarah Bullock wife of John Bullock. Three pounds Current money, to be raised out of my Estate

Item I Give unto my loving Son Thomas Fells, all the rest & residue of my Estate, notwithstanding given & bequeathed during the life of my loving wife Jane Fells, upon Condition that he shall find & provide as full & sufficient maintenance for her during her Natural life as the Circumstances of the Estate will Admit of. And it is my will & pleasure that after the Death of my said wife that my said Son Thomas Fells shall have all the Estate or Link unto him which I do hereby give unto him his Heir & Assign forever.

My Will and desire is that my Estate may not be appraised

And Lastly I do Nominate and appoint my loving son Thomas Fells my whole &
