Item I Give unto my Grandson William Brattle my plantation where I now live together with
all the Land adjoining the same also one Negro Boy named Kent to him & his heirs for-
ever likewise one Bible —
Item I Give unto my Grandson William Hart all my wearing Apparel —
Item It is my Will & Desire that after my just debts are paid that the remainder of my estate
should be Equally divided between my son John Brattle and my Daughter Ann Hart
& my Grandson William Brattle —
Lastly I do appoint my son John Brattle & my Grandson William Brattle my whole & sole
Executors of this my last will & testament, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& seal this 5th day of November 1766
