In the name of God Amen the twenty sixth day of September in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty four. I Bernal Tomlinson of the Parish of Abbeville and County of Sussex being Sick in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be to Almighty God for the same, I do make and Ordain this my last will and Testament, that is to say, first I give & recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it, and my body to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christianlike manner at the discretion of my Executors whom I shall hereafter mention, and as for such worldly estates as it hath pleased God of his infinite goodness to bless me with in this life I give and bequeath in manner and form as followeth.

I give to my brother John Tomlinson twenty pounds Cash, one horse and Saddle one feather bed, and furniture and half a dozen rush bottom chairs a case of bottles & one Cow and Calf.

I give to my brother Thomas Tomlinson my negro man Harry, a long gun. Provided my said brother Thomas pay to Russell Partridge Son of Nicholas Partridge ten pounds Cash as also to Benjamin Weaver Son of Francis Weaver ten pounds Cash.

I give to my brother James Tomlinson my negro man Robin, provided he pay to my brother John the twenty pounds as I gave him as above mentioned.

I give to Theoderick Renn Son of William Renn ten pounds Cash.

I give to Susanna Health the Daughter of James Health five pounds Cash.

I give to my sister Sarah Partridge half a dozen leather bottom chairs.

I give to Francis Weaver my short gun.

I give all my wearing apparel to William Tomlinson Son of Thomas Tomlinson.

I do leave my Land & Plantations and all the residue of my Estate to be sold by my Executors to the highest bidder for money, and the money arising from the Sale after my lawful debts & funeral Charges paid to be equally divided between my Sisters Sarah Partridge, Mary Renn & Ann Weaver.
