In the name of God Amen William Winfield this Twentieth day October one thousand seven hundred and sixty two of Sussex County being Sick and weak of Body but of sound & Perfect Memory Thanks be to God for the same and knowing the uncertainty of this Present life do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in form and manner following, I do in the Humblest manner Refuge my Soul into the hands of God that gave it me hoping for mercy through the Mediation and Intercession of Jesus Christ my Blessed Saviour and redeemer hoping and Desiring like manner by the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named & as for my Temporal Estate which the Lord hath been pleased to bless me with I do leave in manner following first I will that all my just Debts be paid and my Funeral Expenses Discharged.

Item I bequeath to my loving Wife Sarah Winfield the use of the Plantation whereon I now live and namely three Negroes Nan Sue and Lucy During her natural life, and all my household Furniture, also my Stock of Cattle Hogs Horses Sheep and of other Property so ever excepting one Horse Coll that I give to my Son John Winfield. Item I desire that after the Decease of my Wife that my Negroes if there be any born in the time from my Decease to my Wife may all of them be equally divided between my four Sons namely William John John and Peter Winfield to them and their Heirs forever and as for my Household Furniture and Stock be it of what kind or property soever after the Decease of my Wife may be equally divided between all my Children.

Item I give and devise to my Son Abraham Winfield after the Decease of my Wife the Plantation whereon I now live being Two hundred and thirteen Acres to him and to his Heirs forever.

Item I leave my Sons William and Peter Winfield Executors of this my last Will & Testament Nothing in Disannulling all other Wills heretofore made by me, Whereof whereof I hereunto set my Hand and Seal this day and Year above Written.
