In the NAME OF God AMEN I William Winfield this Twentyeeth day October one thousand seven hundred and sixty & two of Sussex County being sick and weak of Body but of sound & perfect memory thank be to God for the same and knowing the uncertainty of this Present life do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in form and manner following, I do in the Humblest manner resign my Soul into the hands of God that gave it me hoping for mercy through the Medication and Intercession of Jesus Christ my Blessed Saviour and redeemer hoping to be received into the number of the blessed and as for my mortal Body to be Buried in a Christian and decent like manner by the Direction of my Executors hereafter named & as for my temporal Estate which the Lord hath been pleased to bestow me with I do leave in manner following first I will that all my just Debts be paid and my Funeral Expences Discharged.

I give to my loving Wife Sarah Winfield the use of the Plantation wheron I now live and namely three Negroes Nan Sue and Honey During her natural life and all my househould Furniture also my Stock of Cattle hogs Hogs Sheep and of hond or Property so ever excepting one House Cott that I gave to my Son John Winfield. My desire is that after the Decease of my Wife that my Heires asf there be any born in the time from my Decease to my Wifes may all of them be equally divide betwix my four Sons namely William, John and Robert Winfield to them and their heire houses and as for my Househould Furniture and Stock be it of what kind or property soever after the Decease of my Wife may be equally divided between all my Children.

I give and devise to my Son Abraham Winfield after the Decease of my wife the Plantation wheron I now live being Two hundred & thirteen acres to him and to his Heirs forever. Item I leave my Sons William and Peter Winfield Executors of this my last Will & Testament Revoking and Disannulling all other Wills heretofore made by me witness whereof I hereunto set my Hand and Seal this day and Year above written.

At a Court held for Sussex County the 20<sup>th</sup> December 1710. The last Will and Testament of William Winfield Dec: was presented into Court by Wm Winfield one of the Executors herein named who made Oath before us as the Law Directs, and the same was proved by the Oaths of John Agnew and Thos Wynne Junr two of the Widders executors and by the Court Ordin'd to be Recorded, & on the motion of the Execut. Certificate is granted him for Obtaining a Probate therof in due form with liberty to Peter Winfield the other Executor to join him theron when he shall see fit.
