

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son John Gilliam my half of Tolam Plantation after he has paid to his Two brothers Hincha ~~and~~ and William Gilliam Two pounds thirteen shillings and fourpence each to him and his Heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath to Amey Chappell Daughter of James Chappell my side Saddle

Item my will and desire is after my Just debts and Legacies are paid that all my Estates of what kind or denomination soever shall be Considered as my ~~deeds~~ Husband's estate and shall be divided amongst my Three Children to wit John Gilliam Hincha Gilliam and William Gilliam as if it was his Estate properly my will and desire is that my said Estate may not be Appraised Lastly I appoint my Brother in Law John Gilliam and Richard Blunt Executors of this my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this Thirteenth day of May One Thousand Seven hundred and twenty Two Signed Sealed and Acknowledged
