Item I Leave my Land and plantation together with all and every other part
of my Estate (except my wearing Apparel) to be sold and after my Just
debts be paid to be equally divided among my Brothers & Sisters hereafter
named Josiah Heath, Thomas Heath, David Heath, Nathan Heath, Jemi-
ma Heath and Betty Heath, and I do hereby appoint my two Brothers Da-
vid Heath & Nathan Heath Executors to this my last Will and Testament, and
my desire is that my Estate be not Apprais'd In Witnesses whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this thirty first day of March
One Thousand seven hundred of seventy three.
