I will that all the Residues and remainders of my Estate after paying my just Debt and funeral Charges be sold at publick sale and to be equally divided among my Children Henry, Emory, Elizabeth, Jean, Mary, Amy, and Susanna and one equal part to be divided between my Son Edwards two Children and to their Heirs forever I will that my Estate shall not be appraised.
