In the Name of God Amen I Faithy Roberts
of Supex County being of perfect mind and Memory Thanks be to Almighty
God and calling to Remembrance the Uncertainty of humane life and that
all flesh must yield to death do make this my last will and Testament in
manner and form following first I recommend my soul to Almighty God who
gave it me trusting in the merits of my Crucified Saviour for the Remission
of my sins and as to settling what temporal Estate It hath pleased Almighty
God to bestow upon me I dispose of as follows (to wit)

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Willm Roberts one Iron Pott to him
and his Heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin Roberts all my Stock of Cattle
Sheep and Geese one Feather Bed and Turniture one Bell Mettle Skillett and half
a Dozen Chairs also all my Crop of Tobaccos after paying the Sheriff my Dues to John
Gilliam what I owe him and to William Roberts Twenty shillingworth of Cloth
out of a Store all this I give to him and his Heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughters Mary and Sarah Roberts and son
Benjamin Roberts three Shores with their Heats to be equally divided amongst them this
I give to them and their Heirs for ever

Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughters Mary and Sarah Roberts one Red Cow and
her five year old Hogs to be equally divided this I give to them and their Heirs
for ever

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Roberts my best Spinning Wheel and
side Saddle to her and her Heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Roberts and son Benjamin Roberts
all my Cotton after the Cotton I owe is paid ^{to be equally divided} to them and their Heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughters Maraland Sarah Roberts all my Crop of What
my wearing apparel and New Cloth to them and their Heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath to my Children John Gilliam Ann Jones Mary Roberts Sarah Roberts
and Benjamin Roberts all my Crop of Corn and Pease to be Equally divided to them and their Heirs for
ever

Item my Crop of Tadder I desire may be left for the use of Mary Roberts Sarah Roberts &
Benjamin Roberts according as they shall have need for wintering their Creatures

Item all the rest residue and Remainder of my Estate after my debts are paid I desire may be sold and
Equally divided amongst my six following Children (to wit) John Gilliam Ann Jones Mary
Roberts Sarah Roberts Willm Roberts and my will and desire is that my said Estate may be approved

Lastly I appoint my son Benjamin Roberts my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will
and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
Twenty first day of September Anno Domini One Thousand seven Hundred and twenty one

At a Court held for Supex County the 13 day of March 1773

The last Will and Testament of Faithy Roberts deceased was presented in Court by Benjamin Roberts
