Item I give and bequeath unto my son William Loftin one negroe man Named Quimby after the death of my wife to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Frederick Loftin one negroe man named Harris after the death of my wife to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rebecka Gilliam one negroe named Salt after the death of my wife to her and her heirs forever,
