he now lives being all that lies on the North side of the Little swamp to him and  
his heirs forever;

Iitem, I give and bequeath unto my son Barret Loftin all my land on the south side of  
the little swamp together with my Mill and plantation and all that appertains  
thereto to him and his heirs forever;

Iitem, I give and bequeath unto my son William Loftin one negro man named Dumoy  
after the death of my wife to him and his heirs forever.

Iitem, I give and bequeath unto my son Frederick Loftin one negro man named Harris  
after the death of my wife to him and his heirs forever.

Iitem, I give and bequeath unto my daughter, Rosella Gilliam one negro named Sall  
after the death of my wife to her and her heirs forever,
