All the rest and residue of my Estate Real and personal of what nature soever I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Carter and her Heirs but if my said Daughter should die before she comes to age or is married in that case I give all my said Estate to be Equally divided between my brother John Daniel and Sister Betsy Temple and their Heirs also I appoint my Brother John Daniel Executor of this my Last Will In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 19th day of February 1773
