Instrument of Writing my last Will & Testament in manner following
(after Recommending my Soul to Almighty God in hopes through the
Merits of our Saviour Jesus Christ, to obtain a happy Resurrection and my
Body to be decently Buried ^{by} my Executors hereafter named.)

I devise unto ^{my eldest} John Tyler of Charles City County Attorney at Law all the Land
whereon I now live containing five hundred Acres more or less to him of his
Heirs forever.

Item I Give unto my said God Son In: Tyler the following Negroes to wit, Ben,
David, Jacob, Tom Bartern, Grace, Kate, Sarah, Alice, Nell, Hannah, Amos,
Sam & Patt to him & his Heirs forever, also all the Stock of Hogg, Cattle,
& Sheep &c. to him & his Heirs forever.

Item I Give unto my said God Son John Tyler the following Homes to wit, Menny
Tom, the Bay mare & Cott and an Iron Grey Cott, also my Riding & harness of Ham
ys, one square black Walnut Table of two feathers Beds one of which has a Truss
of Courtains, also a Tea & Chest to him of his Heirs forever.

Item I Give to my Friend Edward Champion Travis forty Shillings to purchase a
Morning Ring.

Item I Devise unto my Nephew William Tyler all that Tract of Land lying on the
South side of the Poplar I own to him & his Heirs forever also all the Stock thereon.

Item I Give unto my Nephews William & In: of one and My Mill to them & their
Heirs forever, the Expenses of it to be equally Defrayed by them both.

Item I Give unto William Tyler of one and the following Negroes, to wit Will, Peter,
Crispen, Sylvia, Lucy, Mary, George, Frank, Ned, Tytes, Moses Hercules, John
Andrew & Ephraim to him forever. Also my Horse Bow, a Grey Mare & bald
faced Horse three Beds & adext to him & his Heirs forever.

I Devise that debt from me to Peter Jones's Estate of One Hundred & twenty
six pounds Current Money may be paid by my Executors out of a Sum due
me from William Preston in England as soon as it is Recovered on his Bond
I Give the Balance of the said Debt when recovered ^{due} equally to be divid
between Ann Tyler Sister to my God Son John, Ann M: Henzie of the eldest
Daughter of Francis Tyler and if either die the Survivors or Survivor take all.

Item I Devise unto my God Son John Tyler that Tract of Land on the South side
of the Poplar called the Pine Log Quarter containing two Hundred & twenty
five Acres more or less to him & his Heirs forever.

All the Rest of Residue of my Estate of whatsoever kind I Give and bequeath

Bequeath unto my Nephews as are mentioned to be equally divided between them to them and their Heirs forever.

I desire that my Estate may not be Appraised.

Lastly I do constitute & appoint my said Nephews John & William my Executors of this Will Revoking all others. In Witness whereof I have set my Hand & Seal this day of one thousand seven hundred & Twenty two.
