- In the Name of God Amen I John Cocho of the County of Sussex being
 Sick & weak of Body but of sound & perfect mind & memory Thanks be to God
 I do make and ordain this to be my last Will & Testament in manner and
 form as followeth. First My Will & desire is that all my Just Debts and funeral
 expences be paid.
- Item I bind the use of my Plantation and all my Chattels & Goods lieasts and my
 Stock to the use & support of raising my Children this and those I bind to my
 beloved Wife Lucy Cocho during her natural Life or Widowhood only my Horse
 my Will & desire is that he shall be sold to pay my Debts &c
- Item I give & Bequeath unto my Son William Cocho all my Land & Plantation to him
 this Heirs forever.
- Item My Will & desire is — after the death or Marriage of my Wife Lucy Cocho
 that all my Estate should be equally divided among all my Children. I likewise
 do Nominate & appoint my Brother William Cocho and my Wife Lucy Cocho
 Executors of this my last Will and Testament confirming this and no other to
 be my last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set and affixed
 my hand & seal this ^{the} second day of August in the Year of our Lord God 1771.
