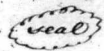

weak of body but of perfect mind and memory, thanks be to almighty god for the same
calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for
all men once to die do make and ordain this my last Will and testament in manner
and form following, that is to say, first and principally I give my soul into the hands
of almighty god who gave it me and body I commend to the earth to be buried in a
Christian and decent manner at the discretion of my executors whom I shall here-
after appoint and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased
god to bless me with in this life I give, devise, bequeath, and dispose the same
in manner and form following.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Betsy Weathers five shillings current money
to her and her heirs forever.

I give unto my daughter Agnes Lills one bed and furniture one mare called Jenny
and my best pot and frying pan the meal sifter and the best pair of Cotton cards
the flax wheel and spinning wheel the best to her and her heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Rebecca Bailey one bed and furniture to
her and her heirs forever.

I give unto my grand daughter Rebecca Weathers one bed and furniture to her and
her heirs forever.

My Will and desire is that my land be divided between my daughters Agnes
Lills and Ann Selley and to be laid off by Morris Lills and John Hawthorn

and Thomas Bailey according as I shall direct them to give it to them and their heirs forever, after my lawful debts are paid the remainder of my estate to be equally divided between Agnes Lillis and Ann Lillis.

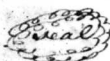
