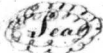

At a Court held for Sussex County the 10th day of November 1778

The last Will and Testament of Hartwell Marable deceased was presented into Court by Edward Marable (the subscribing Witness being dead) who made oath thereto as the law directs and the same was ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the said Edward Marable (George Marable the Executor in the said last Will named refusing to act as such) Certificate is granted the said Edward for obtaining Letters of administration of the Estate of the said Hartwell with the said last Will Testament annexed giving security Whereupon he with William Claiborne Senior and John Tyler his Securities entered into and acknowledged their bonds for his due performance of what the law directs

In the Name of God Amen I Joseph Saxe of the County of Sussex being weak of Body but of sound Memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows, that is to say

First I give and bequeath to my loving Wife Lucy Saxe the use of the plantation whereon I now live during her natural life or Widowhood except one Acre of land whereon the Meeting House stands which said Acre of land I give and bequeath to the society called Methodists forever and after the death or Widowhood of my Wife Lucy I give and bequeath the said plantation to my son Joseph except the Acre as before excepted to him his heirs and assigns forever

I give and bequeath to my son Drury all my lands lying on the north side of the Lightwood Swamp and also a parcel of Land lying on the south side

of the said swamp containing about Eighty Acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows Beginning at the mouth of the Spring Branch and from thence up the said Branch to Nathan Felt's Line thence along the said Felt's Line to the Lightfoot Swamp thence down the said Swamp to the Beginning to him his heirs & assigns forever.

I give and bequeath to my loving Wife during her natural Life or Widowhood the use of Mingo Denah & Mones

I give and bequeath to my son Jesse after the death or Widowhood of his Mother one negroe Man named Mingo to him his heirs & assigns forever.

I give and bequeath to my son Joseph after the death or Widowhood of his Mother one Negroe Man named Amos and one Negroe Woman named Denah and her increase that shall come after my death to him his heirs & assigns forever.

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Lettis Hargrave one negroe Man named Roger and one negroe woman named Agg to her her heirs & assigns forever to be delivered to her at my Death.

I give and bequeath to my son Drury one negroe Man named Othman and one boy named Bristol to him his heirs and assigns forever to be delivered him at my death.

I give and bequeath to my said son Drury one Bed and furniture to be delivered him at my death.

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Selah Phillips the sum of Twenty pounds to be paid her at my death.

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Lucy one negroe Girl named Alice, one Bed & furniture and the sum of five pounds to her her heirs and assigns forever to be delivered her at my death.

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah one negroe Girl named Jane one Bed & furniture and the sum of five pounds to her her heirs and assigns forever to be delivered to her at my death.

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Molly one negroe Girl named Nan one Bed and furniture and the sum of five pounds to her her heirs & assigns forever to be delivered to her at my death.

I give and bequeath to my son Thomas one negroe boy named Ned one Bed and furniture to him his heirs & assigns forever to be delivered him at my death.

I give and bequeath to my son Drury my Young Mare & Mares & Saddle

I give and bequeath to my Loving Wife Lucy Bride after all my just debts and Legacies are paid the use of all the remainder of my Estate during her

her natural Life or Widowhood and after her Death or Widowhood to my Son Joseph to
him & his heirs forever

I do hereby constitute and appoint my Sons Jesse and Thomas and my Son in Law Thomas Hargrove my Executors of this my last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 1st Day of December 1775.
