& Lastly I do nominate constitute & appoint my three living sons William John & Henry Mose and my loving sons in law James Battle & Thomas Burham junior my Executors of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all former Wills and bequests and declaring this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and year above written

Whereby I declare I will not accept, receive, or take any legacy or legacies to me given and bequeathed, or any part thereof, and do renounce all benefit which I might claim by such last Will; and I demand my Dower of all the slaves whereof my said husband died possessed, and also such share of the Personal Estate of my said husband as by a certain Act of Assembly made in the fourth Year of Queen Anne is directed. Given under my hand this Nineteenth day of October anno Domini 1775.
