I Item I give and bequeath to my loving Daughter Lucy Hubbard one Feather Bed & Furniture to her & her heirs forever -

Item. My Will & Desire is that all the Estate of any kind whatsoever which I had with my loving Wife Ann Hubbard be returned to her & her Heirs -  
 Item. I also give to my loving Wife Ann Hubbard ten Barnels of Corn  
 Item. My Will and Desire is that all & every part of my Estate not before mentioned be sold & the Money equally divided amongst my loving Children James Hubbard, John Hubbard, Fathy Lett, Mary Dixon Davis & Lucy - Hubbard to them & their Heirs forever -

Item & Lastly I do nominate & appoint my loving Son Dr. Hubbard & my friend Rich<sup>d</sup> Mason Esq. of this my last Will & Testament hereby making null & void all former Wills & bequests heretofore by me made & confirming this and no other to be my last Will & Testament.  Item I give unto my Son Willet Roberts, all my Land in Supper County to him & his Heirs forever -

Item I give to my Son Archibald, when he comes to the Age of twenty one Years, Two Hundred & Fifty Pounds, to be raised out of my Estate before the Division hereafter directed -

Item, At the Death of my beloved Wife Sarah Roberts I desire that all my Negroes and then Estate of what kind or nature soever it be may be equally divided between my three Children Archibald, Willet and Susanah Boissau Roberts to them & their Heirs forever -

Item, It is desire that if should so happen that neither of my said Children should arrive to the Age of twenty one Years that my Estate be divided as hereafter mentioned -

Item, I give to my beloved Wife Sarah Roberts four Negroes Opre, Pott, Robers & Lemrick to her & her Heirs forever -

Item I leave the Use of all my Lands to my Brother Benjamin Roberts
