 to enable her to raise my children During her natural life further it is my will I desire that
 after my Wifes Decease that all above Lent should be Equally divided amongst all my children
 and the Increase if there be any

Item I constitute and appoint my beloved Wife Susanna Wingfield my Whole and sole Executrix
 of this my last will and Testament and my Desire is that my Estate be not appraised and
 that my Executors may not give Security for the performance of my Will Witness my hand
 and Seal this tenth day of June 1775.
