to enable her to raise my Children during her natural Life further it is my will & desire that
after my Wife Deceased that all above lent should be Equally divided amongst all my Children
and the Increase if there be any

I then I constitute and appoint my beloved Wife Susanna Wingfield my whole and sole Executrix
of this my last will and Testament and my Desire is that my Estate be not appraised and
that my Executrix may not give Security for the performance of my Will Witness my hand
and Seal this death day of June 1775.
