I give and bequeath my Soul to Almighty God that gave it and what Estate it hath pleased God to bless me with in this Life I dispose of the same in the manner & form as followeth -

I give and bequeath unto my loving Wife Mary Tucker my whole Estate both real & personal during her natural Life or Widowhood and at her Decease or Intermarriage my whole Estate Lands &c. to be sold for the best prices that may be had and the Money arising therefrom to be equally divided among my Children that then shall be living, to them each of them and their Heirs forever -

I constitute and appoint my friend Richard Harrison son of Dinwiddie County my whole sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament, leaving it to his Option to dispose of any Part of my Estate as he shall think proper either at private or public Sale for the Payment of my Debts and funeral Expences and Confirming this and no other to be last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 19. day of March One thousand Seven hundred and Seventy Eight -
