Item I give and devise to my son Thomas Wynne Two hundred acres of Land
lying in Dinwiddie County and on the South side of Sapponey Creek to
him and his Heirs for ever likewise Negro Sall and Ben and likewise the
Third Part of my Stock and Household Furniture - - -

Item I give and devise to my son John Wynne the plantation whereon I now
live and three Negroes that is to say Jeff Winney and Senney to him and
his Heirs for ever also the Remainder part of my Household Furniture
and Stock - - -

Item I give and devise to my son Joshua Wynne Ten shillings Sterling

Item I give and Devise to my Daughter Phebe Rainey Ten shillings Sterling and
Further it is my desire that my Two sons Thomas and John Wynne to be my whole &
sole Executors of this my last will and Testament that they should not be compelled to -
give Bond and security for their Appraisement for their Administration and that
my Estate be not appraised In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my Seal the day and Year above mentioned.
