First of all I bequeath my Soul to God hoping that at the general Resurrection to have that united to the Body with both to enter into the Regions of Bliss as to my Body I desire that may be buried according to the decent Rules of our holy Church as to what worldly Goods it hath pleased almighty God to bestow upon me them I dispose of my Debts & Funeral Charges being first paid in Manner & to the Persons following.

I give unto my loving Wife Elizabeth Young one Feather Bed & Trunkers one Cow & Calf & one third Part of the Money due from Maj. John Mason when collected & after my Debts is all paid.

Now I give unto my Son Thomas and to his Heirs forever my Negro Man named Bob as his proper Slave for ever.

Now I give unto my Son Joshua & to his Heirs or Assigns the College Land where Innow lives provided he will paid the Sum of Money I am to give for it otherwise it must be sold by my Executors.

Lastly my Will & Desire is that all the Rest of my Estate consisting of Households Furniture Cattle Horres Hogs with the Crop of Corn & Tadder be sold & after my Debts is paid the Remainder to be equally divided between all my Children.

I do appoint & constitute my Friend George Rivers sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my my Hand & affixed my Seal this fourth Day of October One thousand Seven hundred & Seventy six.
