I give & bequeath five pounds to my Son Henry Brown & his Heirs

- Item I give and Bequeath unto my Son William Brown the Sum of Four pounds to him & his heirs
- Item I give to my Son Benjamin Brown the Sum of Four pounds also one Cow or heifer to him & his heirs
- Item I give to my Son John Brown the Sum of Four pounds & one Cow or Heifer to him and his heirs
- Item I give to my Son Sam^d. Brown the plantation I now live on and all the Lands thereunto belonging to him and his heirs forever I also give unto my said son Sam^d. the Mare Bridle & Saddle that he now makes use of I also give to my said son Sam^d. the Bed & Furniture whereon he now lies also I give to my said son Sam^d. my biggest and least Iron Pott, and my biggest frying pan also I give to my said son Sam^d. one half of my Stocks of Cattle Hogs and Sheep I also give to my said son all my Plantation Utensils also my Cart & Wheels and also all my other Tools also all my Shoe Leather also I give to my said son my Gun and sword and if this my son Sam^d. should die without heir lawfully begotten of his Body my Will and desire is that what I have given him shall be equally divided among all the other surviving ones of my Children
- Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Brown one feather Bed & Furniture
- Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Brown one feather Bed & Furniture
- Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Brown one feather Bed & Furniture
- Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Selah Brown one feather Bed and furniture
- Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Ann Brown one feather Bed & Furniture
- Item I give and Bequeath to my well beloved Wife Sarah Brown the use of one feather Bed & Furniture during her life and after her decease I give the said Bed & Furniture to my Daughter Salariah Brown and my Will & Desire is that all my other house hold furniture not yet mentioned should be Equally divided among my seven Children now living with me or the surviving ones and my Will is that all my other part of all my Stocks of all Kinds shall be divided among all my Daughters or the surviving ones
- Item I give and bequeath to my well beloved Wife Sarah Brown the use of four pounds during her life and after her decease if any left I give it to my son Sam^d. and my Will and desire is that my said son Sam^d. shall take care of his Mother during her life And I do Nominate and appoint my son Sam^d. Brown my whole and sole Executor of this

this my last Will and Testament fully knowing and disannulling all and every other former Wills Testament Legacies & Bequests whatsoever before by me mentioned Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament
