Item I give and devise to my daughter Elizabeth Innes Hancock one negro boy named Peter to her & her Heirs & assigns for ever. Item I give and devise to my Son Clement Hancock my Negro boy named Betty to him and his heirs and assigns forever. Item I give and devise to my Son Michael Wall Hancock my negro boy Davie to him and his heirs and assigns forever. Item My will and desire is that my wife have the use of all my estate not already devised to my Children during her natural life and at her decease to be divided amongst my Children as she shall think proper and lastly I do nominate and appoint my loving wife Rebecca and John Mason sole & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament and desire this my Estate may not be appraised. Nominate and appoint my friends Nicholas Selridge and John Mason
junior Executors of this my last will and testament revoking & do hereby
