The aforeswitten Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Ebenezer Sherman deceased  
was returned and by the Court ordered to be recorded Teste

Will. Blaiborne junr C.S.C.

In the name of god Amen William Heath of the parish of

Albemarle in the county of Suffolk being in reasonable health and of sound mind and memory  
thankes be to god for it, Considering the mortallity of my body knowing that ~~am~~ appointed to  
all men to die do make and apppoint this my last Will in the manner and form following  
Principally and first of all I recommend my soul into the hands of almighty god who created  
me and my body to the earth to be buried in a christian like manner and as to my  
worldly estate that it hath pleased god to blesse me with in this life Give and dispense  
of in manner and form following — I prouesse Slave unto my loving wife Elizabeth  
Heath the care of six negroes namely Will, Jack, Dann, Sioda, Closy, and Alice during  
her widowhood or life. Likewise have the care of my plantation whereon I now live unto my  
said wife during her widowhood or life.

I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph Heath my negro boy named Louis and my negro  
girl called Sarah which he has now in his possession also my negro wench named Closy after  
his mothers death or marriage to him and his heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rebecca Hobbes five shillings current money to her  
and her heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Myrefred Curton forty shillings cash to be raised  
out of the estate but she shall wait for it until it can conveniently be raised out of the  
estate to her and her heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Heath thirty pounds cash to be raised out of the estate  
but he shall wait until it can conveniently be raised out of the estate to him and his heirs  
forever.

I give and bequeath unto my son David Heath one negro man named Will and one negro  
wench named Liddie after his mothers death or marriage also one negro boy named  
Joe also all that part of my land which I had of John Vinson and ten pounds cash one pot four  
one Iron pot also do intend the increase of the wench Liddie from this time for my said  
son David Heath to him and his heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my son Nathan Heath the land and plantation whereon  
I now live also one negro man called Jack one negro man called Dann and one negro  
girl called Alice after his mothers death or marriage one feather bed and furniture  
six pewter plates two dishes one Iron pot and one crospint saw to him and his heirs  
forever.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Jemima Rivers one negro girl called Jerry one Iron  
pot one box Stone hectors one spinning wheel to her and her heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Botley Heath one negro girl called Isabel and  
one negro boy called Ellicks one feather bed and furniture one large red trunk one

one small trunk six plates two dishes one iron pott one spinning wheel  
fifteen pounds cash to be made out of the estate to her and her heirs forever &  
if my said daughter should die before she comes of age or marry my Will  
and desire is that every thing devolved to her in this my Will and desire  
is that it should be equally divided between David Heath, Nathan Heath  
Jemima Rives to them and their heirs forever.

Herm All the rest and residue of my estate not herein before mentioned leave  
unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Heath during her natural life or widowhood  
and after her death or marriage leave it to be equally divided amongst my  
children namely David Heath, Nathan Heath, Jemima Rives and Betty  
Heath to them and their heirs forever.

Herm Give and bequeath unto my Grand son Seth Heath to have the liberty of a cart  
way from the plantation called Newmans to the plantation where his father lived  
where it suits my said son Nathan Heath.

My Will and desire is that my estate may not be appraised neither my executors to  
be obliged to give security for the same And I do constitute and appoint my two  
sons David Heath and Nathan Heath executors. This my last Will & Testament  
disabating all former Wills by me made in testimony whereof I have hereunto set  
my hand and affixed my seal this seventh day of July one thousand seven  
hundred and seventy five.
