I lend to my beloved wife Mary Parker four Negroes Daniel Bush Pall and Surry also one third part of my house hold furniture during her natural life and after her death I desire the said Negroes and furniture may be equally divided between my surviving children.

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Temperance Parker four Negroes Nat. Lucy Man & Sautbridge to her & her heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my Son Archibald Parker the Tract & Parcel of Land whereon I now live likewise four Negroes Sarah Harper Isaham & Isabell to him & his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebekah Parker four Negroes Ben Wilks Selah & Jenny to her & her heirs forever.

All the remainder of my Estate of what kind or quality soever I desire may be sold to the highest bidder & the money arising to be applied to the discharge of my just debts & the overplus to be equally divided among my three Children share & share alike

I do desire in that if either of my said children dies before they come of age or have a lawful heir that his or her Estate be equally divided among my children that
