 and form following. I send to my loving wife Mary Rogers the wife of the
 Plantation I now live on with all the land thereto belonging and all my
 personal estate during her life. I give and bequeath to my daughter
 Elizabeth Rogers one born and half and all my household furniture to
 her and her heirs forever. I give and bequeath to my son Nathan Rogers
 all the remainder of my Stock of all kinds after my wifes death, Likewise
 all my wearing apparel. I give and bequeath to my Son Reuben Rogers
 all my land to him and his heirs forever. I give and bequeath to my son
 Jeph Rogers five shillings Current money. I do constitute and appoint
 my loving wife Mary Rogers and my Son Reuben Rogers my sole and
 sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament Revoking all former writing
 all other Wills by me heretofore made Ratifying and confirming this
 no other to be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have

Two negro men named Jony and Aaron One negro woman named
 Dinah Seven cattle Seven Sheep Six hogs and twelve Pigs about ten
 barrels Corn 3 bush. seed Cotton about 300 lb of tobacco 3 bush Pots & Pans
 Potts & Stone Jugs 3 Glass bottles one feather Bed and furniture. 1 Saddle
 2 Housings 1 gun 1 hand 11 lb. 2 Drunks. 1 pair Pistols 2 Muskets. 2 Powder
 Boxes 4 dishes 11 plates 1/2 dozen knives and forks one Table 8 Chairs
 1 Spinning wheel, 1 pair Steel jards, 1 broad Ax, 1 broad Hatchet, 1 Shore

Shillot, 1 Snow Pettle, 1 glass Hatchet, 1 hand saw, 1 pair fire tongs, 1 boar bone and beaters, looking Glass, a pair of Books and wearing Apparel one candlestick & chimney. 12 lb Tallow, 2 Gallons Brandy, 1 barrel of Powder half gallon of Honey and 3 pint Sugar, some hyder basks.

In the Name of God I John Williams of the Parish of Mattoxey and
County of Suffolk being in perfect Suge and memory blessed be god almighty
and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament and manner and form
following First my will and desire is that the land and hereditary whereon
I now live as soon as convenient after my death be sold for the best price
can be got either for cash or credit which ever my Executrix & Executers
may think best. Item I give to my Son John thirty pounds to him and
his heirs to be paid him when he arrives to the age of twenty one. I give
to my son Robert thirty pounds to him and his heirs to be paid him
when he arrives to the age of twenty one. I give to my son Henry thirty
pounds to him and his heirs to be paid him when he arrives to age of
twenty one. I give to my brother Timothy Rivers thirty pounds to be paid
him when my father departs this life and not before. I lend my fa
ther during his life the House wherein he now lives together with one
half of the College land also three negroes vizt. Cato, Augustus & Liberty and
after his death to return into my Estate. I lend my loving wife all the
residue of my Slaves and personal estate until my son Henry arrives
to age of twenty one, upon those express conditions that she maintain
and educate my children. Its also my Will and Desire that there be a
House built on my College land which I lend my wife
during her natural life, I also lend her the other half the College which
I have before lent to my father after his death during her life. My Will
and Desire is that my estate be kept together by my loving wife for the
support often and my children until my son Henry arrives to the
age of twenty one years and in case of his death until my Son Robert
and in case of his death until my Son John arrives to that age then its
my Will and Desire that my whole estate of every kind whatsoever be
equally divided amongst my wife and children, the part that falls to
my children I give to them and their heirs forever and that to my wife
I lend her during her natural life and after her death to be equally di
vided among all my children. Lastly I nominate constitute & appoint
my loving wife, my brother Timothy Rivers & Augustine Strands Esqrs
Executors to this my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have
hereunto
