I Sepiah Wympe of the County
of Sagwell am grown aged & infirm of body but of sound
Mind & disposing memory for which I thank God and to
to mind the uncertainty of human life & being desirous
to dispose of all such worldly Estates as it hath pleased
God to keep me with I Give & bequeath the same in the follow-
ing manner (to wit) first I reserve all my Estates that
all my Just debts to be paid by my Executors here after
named & I Give to my son William that part of the
Debt due from my son Robert to me named out for William for
One hundred Dollars in trade Likewise to my son Peter & Oliver
the same amount in said bond & as respects my son Robert
I have made him an allowance of One hundred in the
purchase of the land he made from me also I Give unto
each of my sons William Robert Peter & Oliver Each
One Volume of the book Speculator & Each other Book marked
for them they each of them having received a horse head and
Saddle heretofore given I Give & bequeath unto my sons David
Norman & Sepiah all my lands with from the condition
here between me & my son Robert after the death of my wife
also one horse head & Saddle as quick as it can be furnished
them by my Executors at a time they think convenient also each
One Volume of the book Speculator & other books marked to
them I also will & bequeath to all my children each one
Bed & furniture when they can be furnished with it I also will
& bequeath to my daughter Jenny one horse head & Saddle in
like manner with my other children & books in like manner
Also I bequeath my negro girl Fiza to my daughter Jiny
after the decease of my wife not as a bound Slave but be
whenever her wares & returns to receive wages for her labour & if
the should have children for them I become under the same
Regulation after they pay for their raising but those labors
to be equally amongst all my children if they chuse to employ
them I will & bequeath to my beloved wife Mary my land

Not heretofore disposed of & my negro girl Liza during her
natural life also my horse & carriage furniture farming utensils.
Tools cattle sheep hogs & I desire my four youngest children to
have common schoolings out of my estate lastly I do hereby
appoint my brother-in-law David Whitley my son Robert
& my wife Mary Executors to this my last will & testament
thereby revoking all former wills heretofore made by me
In witness whereof I hereunto affixed my hand & seal this
11th day of Novr 1812
