It is my will and desire that some tract of land not disposed of to either of my Children, equal in value to the one they may lose, if there be any such remaining, shall be given unto them.

I also give and bequeath unto my dearly beloved wife all my household furniture, &c &c the proportion of my mansion house for her natural life time,

I do constitute and appoint my sons William P. Hindrick and James P. Hindrick, as the executors of this my last will & testament.

I do hereby make all former wills, by the my last will & testament signed with my hand and sealed with my seal this 29th day of September 1825
