 Testament that is to say I give and bequeath unto my well beloved friend
 and Countryman Will Webb all my Estate real and personal that I
 may be possessed of particularly the Land containing 144 acres,
 adjoining the Land of Benjamin Oney in the said County of
 Russell and for which the said Webb has already my obligation
 to make him a title in fee Simple to the one half which Land is now in
 the possession of a certain John Greenup, who fraudulently without
 my knowledge or consent obtained a patent for the same, to recover which
 I have empowered the said Webb to institute a Suit. I do also appoint
 the said Will Webb sole executor of this my last Will & Testament
 hereby revoking all Wills heretofore by me made. In witness where-
 of I have hereunto subscribed my Name and affixed my seal the
 Seventeenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand
 Seven hundred and Ninety Seven
