 I Thomas Harrison Son of the County of Tazewell and State of Virginia Being Sick and very weak thought of sound mind and disposing, Minory and Colling, to wit the finality of my body and knowing that is appointed here for all things to die do make and declare this my last Will and Testament in the following that is to say first I recommend my Soul to God who gave it and my Body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like Manner and as to my Worldly Estate that it hath Pleas'd God to bless me with I dispose of in the following manner that is to say I give unto my beloved Wife Hannah all my Estate both real and personal during her natural life and at her decease I allow all my Estate both real and personal to be sold unless the direction of Executors hereinafter named and declared in the following Manner I leave to my three Wives children Viz John Harrison Elizabeth Harrison now Elizabeth Edew Mary Croon and Hannah Bishops Seers fifty Dollars each that is fifty Dollars to be divided Equally amongst Hannahs Bishops heirs Being three Mother Heirs part all the balance of my Estate I allow to be Equally divided Between my last wives children that is Joseph Harrison Thomas Harrison James Harrison Samuel Harrison Eliza Thompson Edley Harrison Nancy Gillespie & Alexander Harrison and I do constitute and appoint James Harrison & John Crockett my Executors in Minors what I have hereunto subscribed my name & affixed my Seal this 15<sup>th</sup> day of April 1815 signed and sealed in the presence of us
