In the name of God, on the twelfth Day of March 1818
 being sick in body but of Good and perfect memory,
 thanks be to almighty God and being to Remember the
 uncertain Estate of this transitory life and that all flesh must
 yield unto Death, when I shall please God to call I do make
 constitute Ordain and declare this my last will, and
 testament in manner and form following (recording and annulling
 by these presents all and Every testament and testaments Will and
 Wills heretofore by me made and declared Either by word
 or writing, and this is only to be taken for my last will
 and testament and none other, In the first place I give
 all my part of the Land that I own to my Brother
 Adam and Jacob Wagon Secently I Give twenty four
 Dollars to Polly and Nancy Wagon my youngest Sister
 this is my last will and testament testifying my hand and seal
 this 12th day of 1818

At a Court held for the County of Tazewell the 25th day of July 1818
 the last will & testament of Abraham Wagon was pro-
 ved in Court by the Oath of Benjamin Wagon
 Stephen Lambert witness for the said I ordered to
 be recorded - this John Crockett Clk

I Peter Wynne of Tazewell County, do hereby
 make my last will, and testament in manner and
 form following that is to say, having no family and
 being of lawful age after payment of my last debts
 I give to my sister Peggy Conner's son William my legges
 of land left to me by my father lying in Lee County
 the tract being divided the East End fell to me
 I give to my Brother Sam Wynne the legges of land
 left to me by my Brother Henry in his last will and testament
 and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint Eben Perry and
 Archibald Perry Executors of this my last will and testament
 in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
 this 5th day of May in the year 1818
