 being sick in body but of good and perfect memory
 thanks be to almighty God and willing to Remember the
 uncertain Estate of this transitory life and that all flesh must
 yield unto Death, when I shall please God to call I do make
 constitute Ordain and declare this my last will and
 testament in manner and form following (recording and annulling
 by these presents all and Every testament and testaments Will and
 Wills heretofore by me made and declared Either by word
 or writing, and this is only to be taken for my last will
 and testament and none other, In the first place I give
 all my part of the Land that I own to my Brother
 a down and Jacob Wagon Secondly I Give ninety four
 Dollars to Polly and Nancy Waggon (my youngest sister
