

I Martha King of Tazewell County and Commonwealth of Virginia do hereby make my last will and Testament in manner and form following viz the same wherein I now live containing two hundred acres by Survey so much of it as is legally due in me I wish to be Equally divided between my two sons viz Elijah King and Isaac King I also wish that the Land purchased by my son Isaac King of John Blankenship and Andrew Bebeau with the Appurtenances thereto belonging in the Joint property of my two sons Elijah King and Isaac King to be by them held in their right and property I give unto my beloved Daughter Nancy McMillan one cow worth ten Dollars in good trade and to each of her Children I bequeath as follows viz to Martha McMillan one horse best valued at sixty five Dollars and sixty seven Cents in trade to be delivered to her when she is of full age Jane McMillan I bequeath to her when she is of full age one cow worth ten Dollars in trade to be paid to them respectively as they arrive at full age one Negro Girl called Amy and also one worth of all my personal property of every kind and description to be at my death held as her dower and properly the remainder of all my Estate I desire to be Equally divided between my sons Elijah King and Isaac King my Sister Agnes Thompson I wish to remain in my dwelling house during her life and be supported by my two sons Elijah King and Isaac King and at my death to be decently Buried at their Expence and I do hereby constitute and appoint my two sons Elijah King and Isaac King my sole Executors of this

of this my last will and Testament and directs that they may have my Estate Appraised and return an Inventory thereof to be sealed but that no sale be made of my Estate nor any security required of my Executors but that they carry into Execution every part of this my last will and Testament according to the true Intent and meaning thereof Lastly I do hereby utterly Disavow Revokes and Disannul every other will by me at any time heretofore made and declare this and no other to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 15th Day of November 1809
