In the Name of God Amen I Mary Deskins
Tazewell County State of Virginia being in a low state of health
of sound mind and disposing memory, calling to mind the uncertainty
of life the certainty of death, I do hereby make & declare this
my last Will and Testament in manner and form following. Viz
I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of almighty God
who have it, My body I wish to be interred in the earth in a decent
Christian manner. I do as to such worldly goods as God hath pleased
divine providences to put into my possession I give & bequeath of the
same in the following manner. Viz. I bequeath and desire it
that the whole of the property left in my hands by my dear
husband's will, may be fairly & equally divided among my
three Sons, John Deskins, & Smith Deskins & Stephen Deskins.
I do likewise my little Estate, that this my last Will & Testament
may be proved & recorded, but that no appraisement or sale shall
take place, but the Legatee divide the property equally among
them, and should it so happen, that they the said Legatee cannot
agree upon a division of the property, that then each Legatee shall
choose an interested single man, and shall abide by, & perform accor-
ding to the division made by two persons so chosen, or a majority of
them, and shall take and receive such part of said property as shall
be assigned to them by two men so chosen, and not further recourse
shall be had to Law, in order to establish such division of my
Estate. Lastly, I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and annul
all former Wills, Testaments, Legacies or bequests by me at
any time heretofore made and as declare this and no other to be my
last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this nineteenth day of May in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two 1802
