In the name of God Amen, I Patrick Hindrick of Tazewell County State of Virginia, being weak in body but of sound mind and disposing memory and being desirous to show my business, do make this my last will and testament after the following manner (to wit) My soul I commend to God who gave it, my body to the grave to be buried in a decent and Christian like manner; be hopes of a future and more glorious reward.

I do give and bequeath unto my son William P. Hindrick and James P. Hindrick the said tract of land on which I now live and all my right title and interest to so much of the tract of land on which Brooks Matney now live, as lie on the south side of Clinch River and also all my land lying in the sink, except the Shortridge tract.

I also give and bequeath unto my daughter Polly Clark formerly Polly Hindrick the tract of land on which she now lives.

I also give and bequeath unto my daughter Jane Brown formerly Jane Hindrick the Shortridge tract of land lying in the sink as above named.

I also give and bequeath unto my daughter Isabella Scott formerly Isabella Hindrick a part of the Trout tract of land as may be on the south side of Clinch River, it being the tract on which Robert Shortridge now lives.

I also do will and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Scott formerly Elizabeth Hindrick the plantation on which William Gass now lives together with all the land from the big Spring running down the river on the south side as far as the land extends bounded by the top of the ridge.

I also give unto my daughter Lydia Hindrick the tract of land that John Huse now lives on, and also one horse, bridle and saddle, one cow and calf and one bed and furniture.

I also give and bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Hindrick the tract of land that I have now leave to Daniel Horton lying at the foot of Hewitt Ridge, also one horse bridle and saddle, one cow and calf and one bed and furniture.

The remainder of my real estate not here before specified in this instrument of writing together with my personal estate (to wit) Negroes, Horses, Cattle, hogs & sheep with all the debt due me, I leave for the payment of my debt, and for the support of my dearly beloved wife Elizabeth Hindrick.

I do also bequeath unto my son James P. Hindrich one horse bridle & saddle together with all my remaining utensils,

P.S. In case the title to any of the lands, which I have willed and bequeathed to any of my beloved children (my son William P. Hindrich (expressed)) should not be valid in law, it is my will and desire that some tract of land not disposed of to either of my children, equal in value to the one they may lose, if there be any such remaining, shall be given unto them,

I also give and bequeath unto my dearly beloved wife all my house hold furniture and the possession of my mansion house for her natural life time,

I do constitute and appoint my sons William P. Hindrich and James P. Hindrich, as the Executors of this my last will & testament

I do hereby revoke all former wills, by this my last will & testament signed with my hand and sealed with my seal
