I Rees Bower of Tazewell County and State of Virginia
 do hereby make my last will and testament in manner and
 form following that is to say I ^{will} leave that my Rebecca do
 have all the negroes that I am legally possessed of and also the
 new end of my dwelling house to gether with one hundred acres of
 land adjoining thereto including the grist mill and other
 improvements also two horses and all my other ^{stock} ~~live~~ ^{personal} property
 including Cattle Sheep hogs and house hold furniture and
 farming Utensils and I do further desire that the ^{land} ~~house~~ and
 above bequeathed do at my Wifes Desire be Equally divided
 between my three daughters here after to be named
 2. I give to my daughter Sally a certain Mare known by the
 name of the big mare I give to my daughter Elizabeth a young
 mare now in the possession of James Montgomery and I
 give to my daughter Lucie a barrel mare with a drag
 3. I give to my brothers son Rees Bower all my right and
 interest which I had in a broken tract of land lying on the
 End of the Short Mountain which I purchased of Andrew
 Howard, and holds his title bond for the same & I give
 to my three daughters before named Residue of my landed
 Estate to be Equally divided between them according to quantity
 and quality Reserving to my mother all her right of
 Power which she holds on the premises together with possible
 possessions of one End of the dwelling house in which she now
 lives 3. I give to my Sister son David Ward one two year old
 gray horse 6. I give to my Sister son Rees Ward my
 Rifle gun 7. I give to Nephew Rees B. Thompson my part
 of the Wool Carding Machine by his paying the same of
 the planter and out of the money that will be collected
 for the present years Carding if there is a sufficiency
 after paying all Charges I wish my Executors to
 be paid sixty dollars and if any balance should remain
 I wish it to go to my wife & my ^{three} ~~one~~ of my daughters
 holding my Land Estate I direct that Each of them do pay
 one hundred dollars in property to her married son of Polly
 married so and as the said married arrives at lawful age
 and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friends
 Henry Bower and John Ward Executors of this my last will
 and testament revoking all other former wills
