 I do hereby declare that I am of legal age and of sound mind and
 memory and that I am not married and have no wife living
 to be my co-heir and I do hereby declare that I am not married
 to the said Isaac Jones to his wife, is to maintain me and my
 wife and my life time and to keep my youngest child until
 he is fifteen years old also my two sons Isaac and Harry the
 said Isaac is to keep until they are eighteen years old and at the age
 of twenty one to pay to them fifty Dollars each to be payable
 in a good young Salable horse I give to my son John the
 land from the fore of Ford of the Creek below the mill
 running up the hollow to include the spring, on the south
 side of the Clear fork thence running with the line survey
 to the upper end to the road which I do give to go as discharge
 of money which I am now due to him

I give to my three Daughters Elizabeth and Mary & Sarah
 when they are of age, I give my house hold furniture to be equal
 divided with them in contentment I have hereunto set my hand and
 affixed my seal this 7th of December in the year 1827
