Wm D. Ward administrator of Isaac Ward Deed, Thomas to Court an appraisement Bill of the said Isaac Ward's Estate which was prepared to be recorded
 John Brock Pitt C. C.

I, Wm Pury Son of Fairfax County and State of Virginia do hereby make my last will and testament in manner and form following (17)
 1st I desire that out of my personal Estate my just debts and funeral Expenses be paid & also the payment of my just debts and funeral Expenses
 I give to my Wife Sally one third of my estate both real and personal for and during her natural life and after her decease I give to my children as hereafter mentioned
 2 I give to my son Robert my negro woman Sarah he having owned his part before also in consequence of an exchange of plantations between my Son Robert & Evans and Evans request I give my son Robert Evans's part which is one half of plantation on which I live and being more or less Jeffersons Ville and my negro boy Thomas with I give my son

I give my daughter by James with fifty dollars to be paid out of my personal Estate the having owned his part before & they I give my son Thomas my negro boy Edmund he having owned his part before with I give Henry Pury one half of the plantation I now live on which nearly covers the town of Jeffersonville with the improvements to be equally divided also my negro man Dick I give to my daughter Sophia my negro girl Lulpha I give to my daughter Emily my negro girl Caroline with I give to my daughter Cozly my negro girl Polly with I give to my daughter Polly my two negro girls Susa and Esther and their posterity to they I give to my daughter Mary my negro girl Annetta and her posterity to they I give to my daughter Susa my negro girl Mary
 All that I give to my daughter Cozly the my negro girl Cozly I give to my daughter and as hereafter mentioned the balance of my Estate to be equally divided without any amongst my said daughters that is to say Cicely Sophia Cynthia Emily and Cozly also all my personal Estate to be sold and equally divided amongst my children that is to say Henry Pury Sophia Cynthia Emily & Cozly and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint Pury & John Wynne my trustees in which I have been appointed my seal this 17th day of June 1822
