Pursuant to an order of the County Court of Faywell to us directed we being first sworn for the purpose, have proceeded this 17th day of Dec. 1830 to view and appraise the personal estate of William Thompsons dec'd that was devised by the said William Thompsons to his wife Leticia Thompson who is now dec'd with the slaves that was directed to be sold by the said William in his will of which the following is an inventory
