

Know all men by these presents that I Samuel Cox of the County of Washington and State of Virginia have this day bargained and sold and doth hereby bargain and sell and deliver unto John Duff of the County and State aforesaid one brown mare, two cows one of which is black and white and the other red and white for and in consideration of nine pounds eight shillings the receipt whereof he the said Samuel Cox doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and delivered unto the said John Duff the property above mentioned and hereby warrant and defend the same from the demand or interruption of any person what soever— Now if the said Samuel Cox doth well and truly pay and discharge a certain note which he hath this day given and executed to the above named John Duff according to the payment therein mentioned then and in that case the above property to return back to the said Samuel Cox else to remain the property of said J. Duff. Witness my hand and seal this 10th day of October 1809.

and elsewhere and to act for me and in my names in all business whatsoever - hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney or his substitutes shall do therein by virtue hereof in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 14th day of Jan^y 1809.

WHEREAS William King John Mitchell and George Thompson executed a power of Attorney to Robert P. Currier bearing date Abingdon twenty fourth day of November one thousand eight hundred and three. Authorizing & empowering said Robert P. Currier to settle the business of Robert Mitchell and William King trading merchants under the firm of Robert Mitchell & Co as per Articles of Copartnership between said King and Mitchell bearing date the third day of July one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven, which said Copartnership contract makes known that one half is coming to the heirs of said Mitchell and one half to said William King his heirs &c. This is therefore to certify that said Currier settled said business to our satisfaction as per final settlement the twenty fifth day of April one thousand eight hundred and seven it appearing that the said Robert P. Currier fell indebted on the above settlement to the estate of Robert Mitchell three thousand nine hundred forty one dollars and thirteen cents and to William King three thousand nine hundred forty one dollars and thirteen $\frac{1}{2}$ cents for which said sums Robert P. Currier & Co executed their bond to
