We by leave to report at the request of the admin-
 istrators, a voucher of Robert Caldwell's son
 against the estate of 15/- which being laid before
 us as the foundation of a charge we refer the same
 to the court

(all^d by Court. 15/- charge the estate)

At the further request of the said administrator we
 report that it appears by an instrument of writing dated
 Sept. 25th 1797. signed by Joseph Hays Joseph Colville
 & Robert Montgomery heirs of the decedent that one bed and
 furniture was relinquished by them ^{to Andrew Colville} and that
 consequently that bed and furniture is not taken into the
 above account. Also that the crops of the plantation
 in the year of the death of the intestate was relinquished
 by all the heirs the 14th of Sept 1797 as appears
 by an instrument under their hands. And
 that a bond of Ephraim Johnson for £52
 given in the lifetime of the intestate for 4 acres
